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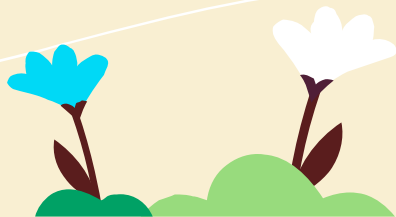

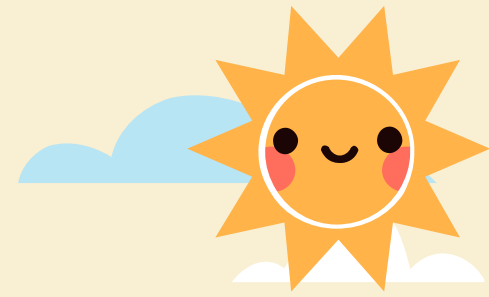

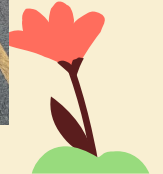
Students are the heart of our campus, and contributed greatly to the culture of belonging on campus and rootedness in our community during the 2023-2024 school year.

Faculty-Led Initiatives



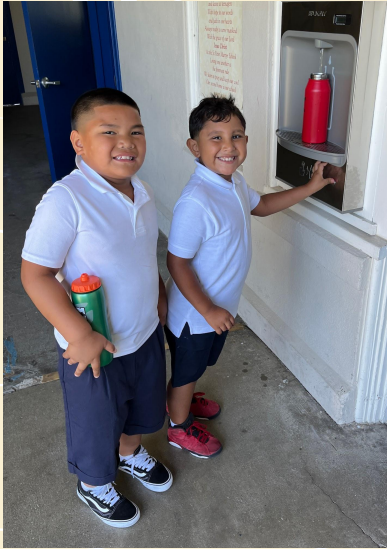

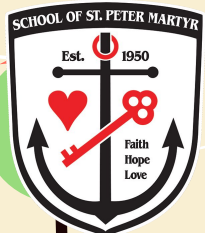

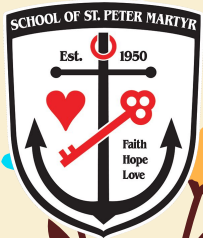
