 - *The goals that speak most deeply to us are the **Response to the Cry of the Poor**, the **Response to the Cry of the Earth**, and the call for **Community Resilience and Empowerment**.*
 - *Inspired by Laudato Si' and reaffirmed by Fratelli Tutti, we see that poverty alleviation, peace-building, and ecological restoration cannot be separated. Our community has been inspired to develop **#1ticket1mangrove**—a global solidarity initiative where every film ticket (USD 10) funds the planting of one mangrove tree and contributes to education, clean water, and cooperative-based economic empowerment in **East Nusa Tenggara (Indonesia) and Timor-Leste**.*
 - *This has changed how we approach development: not as charity alone, but as **integral ecology**, combining justice for the poor, reconciliation across borders, and restoration of creation.*

*Our communities, especially in NTT and Timor-Leste, face **dual vulnerabilities**:*

- ***Environmental**: degraded coastlines, water scarcity, and climate-related disasters.*



- **Social:** persistent poverty, limited educational infrastructure, and unresolved cross-border tensions.

The socio-ecological crisis has shown us, in real terms, how “everything is connected.” Without clean water, children cannot study; without peace, economies cannot flourish; without ecological restoration, livelihoods collapse. These realities call us to action that is both holistic and urgent.

● What is your mission and/or your values?

*Our Vision : Bless the NATIONS with our talents and Our mission is to **transform vulnerability into resilience** through faith-driven action, solidarity, and cooperative economics.*

Our values are rooted in:

- **Fraternity and peace** (Fratelli Tutti)
- **Care for creation** (Laudato Si')
- **Justice and dignity for the poor** (Catholic Social Teaching)
- **Participation and subsidiarity** through cooperative structures

● How do your unique mission and/or values and identity connect with the Laudato Si' Goals?

*Our unique mission is to **transform vulnerability into resilience** by combining **cooperative economics, ecological restoration, and peace-building across borders**. This identity is deeply Catholic: rooted in solidarity, subsidiarity, and the preferential option for the poor.*

- With Fratelli Tutti, we embrace **universal fraternity and social friendship**, making cross-border reconciliation between NTT and Timor-Leste a priority.
- With Laudato Si', we embrace **integral ecology**, recognizing that human dignity, environment, and social justice are inseparably linked.
- With Catholic Social Teaching, we pursue **justice, dignity of labor, and the common good** through cooperative enterprises.

By joining, we align our local struggles and creative responses with the **universal Church's mission**.
